### What is the BIIAB AALP(SR)?

### What does the qualification **cover**?

The BIIAB AALP(SR) covers three key subject areas, including:

#### **Principles of Assessment**

- The assessment process.
- Arranging, planning and undertaking assessments.
- Making assessment decisions and providing feedback.
- Quality assurance of assessments.

#### **Legislative Requirements of Licensed Premises**

- Introduction to the legislative requirements of operating licensed premises.
- The Licensing Objectives.

#### **Assessing Recognised Award Schemes**

- The role of recognised award schemes.
- The role of evidence.
- Basic communication.

## Who is the BIIAB AALP(SR) for?

The BIIAB AALP(SR) is designed for prospective recognised award scheme assessors for example from:

- Police forces.
- Local authorities.
- Trading standards offices.
- The fire service.

As well as BIIAB nominated tutors; CDRP/DAAT team members and other A1 qualified independent representatives.

## How is the learning assessed?

The BIIAB AALP(SR) is assessed by two multiple-choice question examinations.
