
It has been brought to our attention that there are a number of student unions around the country who now have PASS accreditation for their student union cards. These cards meet all the necessary PASS criteria including a photograph and details of the holder's date of birth.

Whilst our handbooks only make reference to what is an acceptable proof of age, it should be made clear to candidates that **any** card with the PASS logo is a valid proof of age, not just specific proof of age scheme cards.

Many of our questions regarding valid proof of age contained reference to student union cards. All these references have now been removed and the questions have been overridden to ensure that any questions in current exam papers will not disadvantage candidates.
