It is important for you to understand your responsibility regarding amusement with prizes (AWP) machines.</p> <p>c) You must be aware that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Licensed premises are permitted to have limited-prize gaming machines of two categories, with a cash prize up to £35 (Category C) or a cash/tokens prize of up to £8 (Category D) • No permit is required for up to two machines on the premises • All-cash Category C machines are restricted to persons aged 18 and over and must display clear signage forbidding play by under 18s and be positioned so that they can be supervised by staff • There is no age or location restriction on the use of Category D machines.
